

# EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES TERMS AND CONDITIONS 2023-2024

#### **REGISTRATION:**

Florimont offers a wide choice of activities; registrations are limited to two per student to avoid overburdening children. Please check any age requirements and the days and times of activities chosen at the time of registering.

Most activities are held during lunch break: 12.00-12.55 in Primaire (Primary), 1pm-1.45 in Cycle (Middle School) and 12.45-13.45 in Secondaire 2 (Diplomas).

Activities start on Monday 11 September 2023 and continue until the end of May 2024.

As places are limited, registrations are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Once a course is full, any subsequent registrations are placed on a waiting list and parents notified.

The first session is viewed as a taster session; the student is then considered to be committed to the activity for the school year. Course fees are due from this point and the student agrees to attend all classes.

## **CANCELLATION:**

Institut Florimont reserves the right to cancel one or more sessions if the instructor becomes unavailable (due to sickness, accident, etc.) or in the event of a major incident affecting the Institut. Cancelled classes will either be made up at a later date or not charged.

The activity will not be refunded if:

- A registered student is not committed to the course or if they stop attending classes without notifying the school.
- A student is excluded from a class due to repeated inappropriate behaviour.

Institut Florimont reserves the right to withdraw an activity if there are insufficient registrations, or refuse a registration if payment is not made within 15 days of receipt of the invoice. Parents will be notified by email.



## PRIVATE MUSIC LESSONS
