

Pronote

Pronote is a software package teachers can use to input their students' grades and share them with parents, while students can view their grades by subject and school reports. Pronote can be used to manage grades and assessments, and enables students, parents and teachers to view an individual's grades and progress. It also has options for managing timetables, class notes and communication between teachers and parents, so no one misses out on important information.

WHAT IS PRONOTE FOR?

Teachers can use Pronote to manage their classes, their students and share information and resources. It can help create lesson plans, MCQs and examinations, as well as managing grades and assessments and communicating with parents. Students can use it to see their grades, class notes, timetables and instructions from teachers.

Pronote gives a snapshot of every aspect of school life. Teachers can track their students' progress, set them work and communicate with parents, while students can view their own progress and communicate with teachers. It ensures clear and open exchange between everyone involved in the child's education and school life, including managing absences and homework. Pronote is really useful to students as it helps them:

- do their lessons
- manage their time
- get organised

Pronote helps parents liaise with teachers and see how their child is getting on.

Seesaw

Seesaw is a school app that manages communication between teachers, students and parents; it is a digital portfolio which allows everyone to view the student's progress. Students can use it to share school work, exercises and audio recordings with teachers and parents.

Parents can use Seesaw to see exactly what their child is doing in class. There are two versions: Seesaw Class for teachers and students and Seesaw Family which handles communication between teachers and parents. Students can use Seesaw to connect to each other via their tablet or laptop and interact with their classmates' posts.

SEESAW CLASS: DIGITAL PORTFOLIO FOR STUDENTS

The Seesaw app makes it very simple for teachers to set up school activities and avoids the need to create a website. It gives students an interactive platform to present, explain and show what they have learned.

Seesaw Class allows pupils to:

- Connect with other students anywhere in the world
- Record their progress as they read a book and see how their skills improve (reading speed, fluency, expression, etc.)
- Practice their communication skills by presenting or telling a story inspired by a picture
- Share their arts projects and see what their classmates have done
- Write a story inspired by a drawing
- Assess their reading comprehension by taking a photo of the book cover and writing or making a voice recording of their summary
- Take a photo of their maths work to check their method

Seesaw is a practical and effective tool to keep students, teachers and parents up-to-date with school work.
